

BYELAWS NOTICE

THE MOOR & ODNEY COMMON, COOKHAM.

The Commons Act, 1899.

Cookham Parish Council, under power delegated to it on 19th August 1925, and specifically pursuant to Byelaw (20) of the Bye-laws for the prevention of nuisances and the preservation of order on The Moor & Odney Common does hereby NOTIFY all persons on or using the Moor & Odney Common in Cookham that it has appointed a:

CHIEF COMMONS OFFICER

who may after due warning remove or exclude from the Common any person who within his view commits, or whom he reasonably suspects of committing, an offence against any of these Byelaws or against the Vagrancy Act, 1824
